

# Writing at OAW

At OAW we teach Writing through 'The Write Stuff' approach. This creates 'impact writers' who understand that when they are writing they need to consider the impact of their language choices: they know that everything that they write has an impact on the reader.

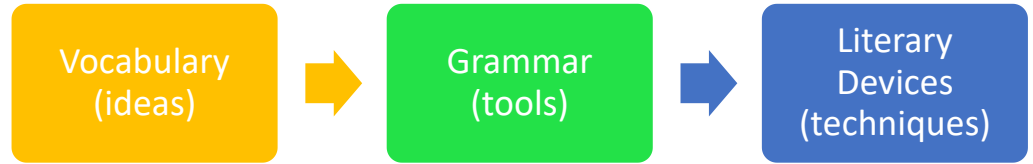
## Teaching sequence

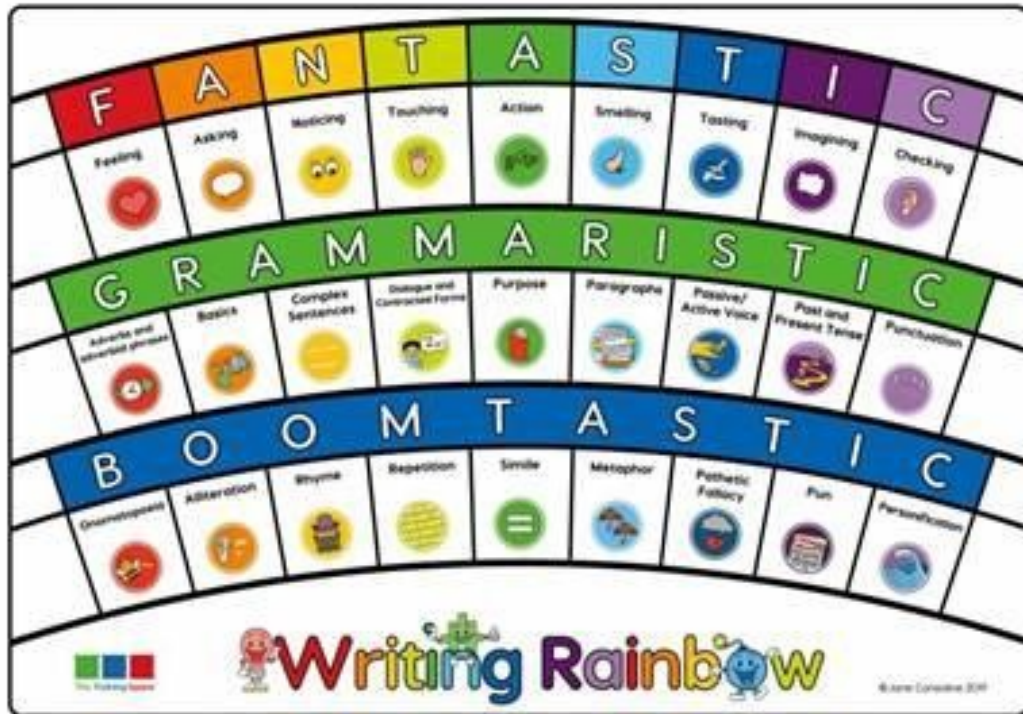


## The Three Zones of Writing

There are three zones of writing which are taught during the lessons:



These are taught through the Fantastics, Grammaristics and Boomtastics, which can be seen below on the Writing Rainbow.



These are then intentionally introduced across the key stages to ensure our children leave us with a wealth of techniques, flair and grammatical understanding to communicate effectively in written format wherever their future takes them.
