Year 6 WW2 Workshop.

Dear parents/ carers,

We have a very exciting workshop on **Wednesday 28th January 2026** hosted by Jim (a former teacher and history enthusiast) from 3R's Solihull. The aim of this company is to encourage students to revisit, revise and remember history in a way that may not be always possible in the typical school day.

For our WW2 themed day, Jim will bring in a variety of artifacts, which children are allowed to handle and explore, to illustrate the events being told. Across the day, children will explore the Blitz, evacuation, Dunkirk and rationing. Every child will receive a week's chocolate ration and compare it to their weekly intake of sweets. They will also plan a weekly shop on the basis of their rationing limits. All activities are resourced and planned by the 3 Rs prior to the day and will be supported by class teachers.

Due to this being an external company, there will be a small cost for this workshop of **£5** per pupil. This payment will need to be made through MCAS by **Friday 23rd January 2026**. This day was a real highlight of the year with our previous cohort, and they were talking about this workshop in the following months – we know it will be just as much of a success this year!
