Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

We would like to update you about Reading and Seesaw Challenges in Reception.

Reading is one of the golden threads of our curriculum here at Oasis Academy Warndon, and we want to instil a love of reading in every child. We also want to ensure that children are developing the skill of reading, learning how to decode words and blend to become confident readers. A key focus of ours is also Communication and Language and development of self-care skills, which is developed daily in the classroom and through Seesaw Challenges at home.

Reading must be logged on Boom Reader four times throughout the week. Seesaw Challenges must be completed on children's iPads in the 'Activities' section. If your child does not take their iPad home from school, or you have any issues with logging, Seesaw challenge videos can be sent through the parent messaging section of Seesaw to the class teacher.

Children that complete their **Seesaw Challenge** and **log their reading 4 times per week on Boom Reader** will be invited to an exciting activity on a **Friday**. This could include a 'Reading Rave', an Afternoon Tea treat or extra iPad time!
