Key Reminders

- **Forest School.** These sessions will continue every Wednesday. The children can wear their own clothes but we advise long sleeved tops and full length trousers to protect against nettle stings. Please ensure they have named wellies and a change of shoes and a sun hat.
- **Books-** the children will choose a book and bring it home to share every Monday. Please return the book on the following Friday. Books will be logged on the GoRead app. You will have recently received a letter with login details. If you have not got this information please speak to staff.
- **Attendance** is incredibly important throughout the school year. Children need to be attending regularly as they are learning important skills that will help prepare them for the next stage of their school life.
