PSCO Visit

Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) curriculum, we would like to inform you that our local Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) will be visiting school on **Wednesday 29th April** to work with the Year 6 children.

During the session, the PCSO will lead a discussion on **anti-social behaviour**, focusing on themes that are particularly relevant as the children prepare for their transition into Year 7. The session will cover:

- What anti-social behaviour is and how it is defined in law
- Possible consequences of engaging in anti-social behaviour
- How and when to report anti-social behaviour
- Key considerations as children gain greater independence moving into secondary school

This session is designed to support pupils in understanding their responsibilities within the community and to help them feel confident and informed as they move on to Year 7. Children will also have the opportunity to ask questions in a safe and supportive environment.

Please note that this session is a planned part of our PSHE curriculum and is **not an opt-out session**.
