This is due to children not knowing which bottles are theirs, causing the children to drink from the wrong bottles and with COVID and other germs we want to try and reduce cross contamination as much as possible. Please be assured we will provide your child with milk and water during their session. Thank you for your understanding.

Children do not need P.E kit. But could you please ensure your child is wearing socks and easy to remove footwear as your child will be encouraged to take off their own socks and shoes independently.
- **Forest School will be on a Wednesday**
