

Tuesday Enrichment Mornings for Reception

What is Enrichment Morning?

Every Tuesday morning we will have an Enrichment Morning where we will develop a variety of skills. Each week we will have a range of exciting and engaging activities that will support the children's learning in addition to developing their characteristics of effective learning.

What activities will there be?

Some of the activities will include:

- Cooking
- Woodwork Skills
- Making our own dough
- Dance
- Music
- Planting and Growing
- Visits from special guests
- Visits to our local community
- Forest School
- Many more!

When will my child attend Forest School?

This year, Forest School will be conducted in small groups instead of the whole year group. This will make the sessions purposeful and will allow children to develop new skills such as knot tying, den building, cooking on a real fire and sawing. Each group will contain approximately 15 children who will attend Forest School for six weeks during Enrichment Mornings. Once their group has finished at Forest School, they will participate in the alternative activities listed above.

You will receive a letter approximately 1-2 weeks before your child's Forest School sessions begin which will contain more details regarding clothing and dates and where you will be asked to sign and return a permission slip.

Clothing

As the children will be participating in a variety of activities that might get messy throughout the morning, you are welcome to send your child in own clothes every Tuesday. These should be clothes you are happy to get messy – not their favourite party outfit!
